## BYOD – Frequently Asked Questions

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### What are the consequences for failing to abide by the BYOD Student Code of Conduct?

1st Offense: Personal Device will be confiscated and placed in a secure location where the owner can retrieve it at the end of the day

2nd Offense: User will lose the privilege to have a personal device for 2 weeks.

3rd Offense: Personal Device will be confiscated and placed in the office where a parent will be required to come to school to retrieve it.

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### What should I do if my personal device is damaged or lost?

If it happens outside of school – Let your teachers know that you will be without your device and for how long.

If it happens in school – Immediately report the incident to your homeroom teacher.

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### What happens if I forget to bring my device to school or to fully charge my device?

Our school is equipped with computers for student use throughout the school year. Occasional forgetfulness is expected as we all imperfect children of God.

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### What if a student does not have a personal device available for use in school?

Students are encouraged but not required to bring in a personal electronic device. The Saint Mary School BYOD program is intended to supplement the technology devices provided by the school to support teaching and learning the curriculum
